

Integrity and Character in Dream Interpretation

- Read 1 Cor. 13:1-2
- Read Joshua 1:8
- Read Psalm 25: 21 (amp.) Let Integrity and uprightness preserve me, for I wait for and expect you.
- Read Job 33: 14-18
- To have **integrity** is to do the right thing even if no body else sees you, even if it costs you or hurts you.

Forgive; Let it to, make an end to it fully, freely, and finally.

If God didn't say it, you don't say it!!!!!! The flesh or the devil will be trying to add or subtract when you are interpreting. Resist him and he will flee.

- **Confidentiality**

Jesus is the only fail safe solution to all confidentiality issues in ministry. We can't cover all the issues, but Jesus can.

We want to provide you with foundation of good practice that will reduce the potential of issues that might arise.

Definition: Confidentiality means maintaining the secrets of clients.
Secretary means one who keeps secrets.

Concept of Confidentiality: Protection of all Communication

Purpose of Confidentiality: While protection the person encouraging candor (open up) so they will feel protected to give more information; thereby giving more details of a dream or vision.

If you make notes, they have a right to read them.

If you are going to use their dream ask permission.

If ungodly things are repetitively happening inform Pastor.

If you give Pastor data be sure it is accurate.

Galatians 3:13 and Col 2:14-15 covers written or spoken curses.
John 20:23 Remember we do not retain sins or Matthew 7:7 or
judgements on anyone.

- **Group Settings:** You must set a norm of confidentiality regarding group participants disclosures.
- **Work in Team:** Please recognize and respect the gifts of others in ministry. Numbers 11:14-17

How many ministers can relate to the frustrations of Moses? Have you poured out your strength and soul in service to the church? Have you fought spiritual battles alone? Have you bore the burdens alone? Have you stood in the gap alone and become weary of ministry and even of life? ***Well! God has a better way!*** And it is simple! You don't have to do it alone! Like Moses, appoint, seek out, and find able men and women of truth, hating covetousness, and fearing God. If Moses needed others to minister along side him- Moses, you know the one who communicated with God face to face-

- **Competition:** There is room for us all at the Cross.

Somewhere we must stop and pray over our concept of ministry. Please discover that the Biblical idea of team ministry recognizes the worth of all ministries of God.

Proverbs 11:14 Where no counsel is, the people fall; but in the multitude of counselors there is safety.

Proverbs 15:22 Without counsel purposes are disappointed: but
In the multitude of counselors they are established.

Proverbs 24:6 For by wise counsel thou shalt make they
war: and in multitude of counselors there is safety.

- **Submission** to Leadership is a requirement in the body of Jesus Christ.
