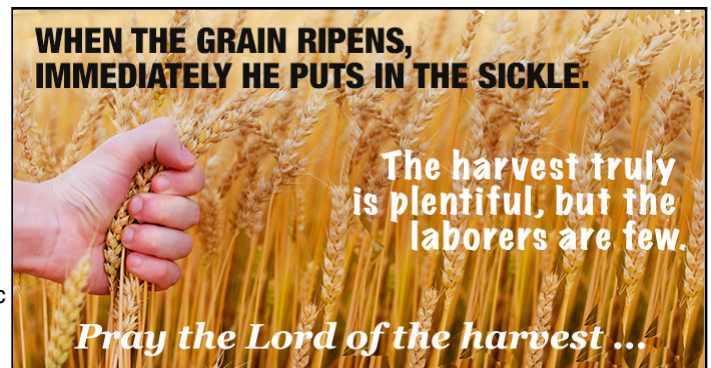

## Harvest

*Do you not say, 'There are still four months and then comes the harvest'? Behold, I say to you, lift up your eyes and look at the fields, for they are already white for harvest! **John 4:35***

Billy Graham once said that growing up as a farm boy in North Carolina, he new that harvest season was short. God wants each of us to have a harvest. Each of us was born in this specific prophetic time for a purpose. Just as Esther was born for such a time as this.

They could be in darkness hoping for light even while a smile may be on their face.

People can cover a multitude of needs and hurts with a fake presence. A random act of kindness or a simple sharing of faith or a word of compassion could be all they need to open up and receive what the Lord is desiring to give. Just be sensitive to the leading of the Holy Spirit. He will prompt you as to what you should say or do.

I remember once as a young Christian I was shopping for a new car. I worked in the country hauling hay and always wore jeans. Perhaps they were tighter than the salesman thought they should be and he began making suggestive comments, asking about my boyfriend and such. I finally blurted out that Jesus was my boyfriend. He was quite for awhile and then asked if I minded if we stopped and talked for a minute. He was older and almost began crying and said that he unfortunately had gotten away from his faith but he knew the Lord was calling him back. I pray the Lord did get him back and am hopeful that my simple comment may have led that.

Many of us feel inadequate and lack the boldness of a Billy Graham preacher. Be not ashamed of the gospel of Christ for it is the power of God for salvation. If we are mocked because of it, we are in good company. Jesus also was mocked - even on the cross. It is their loss and they are to be pitied.
