

Unsearchable Love

Unsearchable - not searchable; not lending itself to research or exploration; not to be understood by searching; hidden; unfathomable; mysterious

Love - a profoundly tender, passionate affection for another.

The Word teaches us that whosoever dwells in love dwells in God, for God is love. It's not just one of His characteristics, it is the essence of His being. It is that unsearchable love that drove Jesus to suffer the humiliation, suffering and death of the cross.

Truly there have been many men of God who knew their God in a special way. I know I have not gone nearly so far into that realm as they, but my soul longs for the depths they knew and more. I long for the experience of Ezekiel 47:3-6. I long to swim in Him and indeed to drown in Him. I seek for more and more of the Holy Spirit to fill me. I don't know why anyone would just seek Him for what heaven will bring when there is so much of Him to be had here and now. He is seeking that passionate bride that desires Him more than life. He will cleanse her and clothe her in righteousness.
