do you need a washing

"that He might sanctify and cleanse her with the washing of water by the word." eph 5:26

have you ever watched something or done something that just made you feel dirty all over?in a way, i guess that's a good thing because it means your sensibilities are still intact. you are still able to be moved by the gentle urgings of the Holy Spirit; the urgings that whisper, "your ears shall hear a word behind you, saying, 'this is the way, walk in it,' whenever you turn to the right hand or whenever you turn to the left." isa 30:21
